The Community Outcomes Model for Prevention and Sustainable Success (COMPASS) is a new initiative that brings together exemplar programs from across the country to advance outcomes-based financing. Through COMPASS, we are advancing innovations that improve patient and community health outcomes by changing how they are funded – not through overreliance on a single grant, government, or sector, but through more sustainable payment models.

Participating programs are forming a Community of Practice within the [Common Health Coalition](#) to accelerate the adoption and impact of outcomes-based financing models. As part of this Community of Practice, COMPASS programs will identify, synthesize, and share best practices that will both strengthen existing programs as well as help launch future outcomes-based financing initiatives. The COMPASS programs primarily focus on three health challenges: cardiovascular disease prevention, opioid overdose prevention, and improving maternal health outcomes. However, the financing models, strategies, and lessons developed through COMPASS will be adaptable across a wide range of health challenges.

At a time when many proven prevention and community health programs struggle to secure sustainable funding, COMPASS aims to strengthen the evidence base for outcomes-based financing and advance payment models that reward measurable improvements in health outcomes. By making it easier to finance what works, COMPASS seeks to expand the reach of effective programs and improve long-term community health.
